

# 2017-18 JBT POINTS SYSTEM

Points are very important in the JBT world. Here's how you earn JBT points:

**Participation- 10 points for each JBT event you enter**

**Final Standings- 100 Points for first, down to 10 for 25<sup>th</sup>.** (1<sup>st</sup>= 100; 2<sup>nd</sup>= 80, 3<sup>rd</sup>= 70, 4<sup>th</sup>= 60, 5<sup>th</sup>= 50, 6<sup>th</sup>= 48, 7<sup>th</sup>= 46, 8<sup>th</sup>=44, 9<sup>th</sup>= 42, 10<sup>th</sup>=40, 11<sup>th</sup>=38, 12<sup>th</sup>=36, 13<sup>th</sup>= 34. 14<sup>th</sup>= 32, 15<sup>th</sup>=30, 16<sup>th</sup>= 28, 17<sup>th</sup>=26, 18<sup>th</sup>=24, 19<sup>th</sup>=22, 20<sup>th</sup>=20, 21<sup>st</sup>=18, 22<sup>nd</sup>=16, 23<sup>rd</sup>=14, 24<sup>th</sup>=12, 25<sup>th</sup>=10. Certain events, as noted on the schedules, are worth double or other multiples of these point values. The Invitationals are worth triple points, and the TPC is worth quadruple these values. Only the above finishing position points are doubled/tripled/quadrupled.

**High Games -25 for 1<sup>st</sup>, 20 for 2<sup>nd</sup>, 15 for 3<sup>rd</sup>, 10 for 4<sup>th</sup>, 5 for 5<sup>th</sup>.** These are awarded to the high games, scratch and handicap, of the entire tournament, at no additional entry fee. Tied scores split points, rounded up. In multiple squad events, any high games from the 'dropped' scorecard(s) do count (revised for 2014-15).

**Round by Round Leaders- 5 points per round.** Most JBT events have a format that results in a leader after each round. When this is the case, the leader earns 5 points per round, so in a 'classic' format event, that's 40 points up for grabs. Ties for the lead have both bowlers getting the 5 points. Events with multiple qualifying squads award the 5 points after the leaderboard is combined.

**Qualifying Round Leaders- 25 for 1<sup>st</sup>, 15 for 2<sup>nd</sup>, 10 for 3<sup>rd</sup>.** Most JBT events have a qualifying round. In those events, the 3 top qualifiers earn the above points, ties splitting points.

**"JBT" Dress Code Bonus- 10 points.** Bowlers wearing slacks, neat khaki or cargo shorts, or neat skirts, plus a PBA-acceptable shirt (collared, 'mock', or brand logo 'mock T'), with their names (or college or high school) on back (or front chest), or the season 16-21 logo shirts, with or without names, receive an extra 10 points. ## **WHY POINTS MATTER:**



The top 32 point scorers in each division at the end of the regular season, in each Conference, qualify for that Conference's Invitational, featuring a \$1,000 top scholarship.

The top 5 point scorers in each division going into the Invitational receive an exemption into the finals of the Invitational, guaranteeing a minimum \$50 scholarship at that event.

The top 20 point scorers in each division after the Invitational qualify for the Touring Players Championship, featuring a \$2,000 first place scholarship.

The top 100 point scorers in each division on the combined All-Conference points lists also qualify for the TPC.

The top 12 point scorers in each division on the combined All-Conference points lists, and each division's Bowler of the Year, earn an exemption into day 2 of the Touring Players Championship.

The point leaders after each Invitational are that Conference's Bowlers of the Year, and the All-conference points leaders after the TPC are the All-Conference Bowlers of the Year!

The top 32 in All-Conference points compete in a special "TPC Elite" event at the TPC, with bigger bonuses the higher up within the top 32 you finish- so EVERY point matters, not just 'getting in'!
